



This Time Last Year

"Unemployment Help" with nearly 4.6 million unique pageviews. During this same timeframe in 2021, this page experienced a 94% decrease in visits with only 293,968 unique pageviews. **Unemployment Help**

During Q3, that new content had close to 550K unique pageviews with the most traffic going to pages on stimulus checks in English and Spanish.
